Cemetery Rules and Regulations

Purchase of Graves

- 1. Purchase of graves shall be conducted through the Township Cemetery Sexton with the deed being issued by the Township Fiscal Officer. The cost of a four foot (4') by eight foot (8') plot is \$250 for township residents and \$500 for non-township residents.
- 2. No township resident may purchase graves for a non-resident at the township resident cost.
- Lots may not be transferred from one individual to another. The Township
 may repurchase unused graves at the original purchase price and resell said
 grave at current price.

Burial Procedures and Costs

- 1. Full burials must use a concrete or galvanized metal vault.
- 2. Cremations must use an urn of the permanent type constructed of marble, manmade stone composition, bronze or steel.
- 3. The Township must receive forty-eight (48) hours notice for burials.
- 4. There may be one full burial and one cremains burial or two cremains burials or 1 full burial and one infant burial per lot. In the case of indigent burials where the Township is responsible for all burial costs, up to six cremains may be placed on one burial lot.
- 5. In the event a disinternment is requested, the family will be responsible for any and all costs associated with said disinternment.
- 6. A valid burial permit or certificate of cremation is required for all burials.
- 7. The following fees for burials will be charged by the Township:

Markers

- All grave markers in Section 5, 6A, and Section 6B of Myrtle Hill Cemetery or any new sections of any Township cemetery must be flush. Raised markers and/or monuments are permitted in older sections of Township cemeteries. All foundations and markers must be approved by the Township Cemetery Sexton.
- 2. Headstone foundations must be contracted by the family through the contractor appointed by the Township. Foundations must be constructed in accordance with generally accepted construction standards.

Flowers and Decorations

1. All flowers and decorations must be removed by the fifteenth (15th) day of each month.
